

Push your limits with our NEW off grounds Outdoor Challenge Each day is a different challenge!

Push It To The Limit is an advanced wilderness camp for boys and girls in grades 7-10. This week is programmed for those who love spending time outdoors in any element and who are looking to gain even more outdoors and survival skills. Campers will learn a multitude of outdoor skills, including fire-building, tracking, survival shelter construction, tool making, and navigation. Campers will also be able to apply these new skills during competitions throughout the week. If your child is looking for a challenge, consider sending him to Push It To The Limit! While on our trips your child will learn how to build communication skills, self-confidence, leadership, trust and balance as well as how to develop collaboration, innovation and creativity.


